Position Summary

Park Place Seniors Living is currently looking for dedicated, motivated, and passionate individuals to join our team as Hospitality Aides, working at Multi Generational Housing & Community Centre.

Duties and Responsibilities Include:

- Vacuums, dry mop and wet mops all floors.
- Cleans bathroom, commodes, lifts and other equipment as assigned.
- Performs daily, routine and terminal cleaning of resident rooms including disinfecting beds and turning/flipping mattresses, cleaning of windows and blinds/curtains.
- Strips, refinishes and polishes floors.
- Ensures housekeeping equipment is clean and reports any equipment needing repair to Housekeeping Supervisor and/or Maintenance.
- Understand and follows PPSL Infection Prevention and Control policies and procedures and Universal Precautions in handling body fluids.
- Identifies and reports risks to ensure the safety of residents, visitors and staff.
- Responsible for cleaning job duties and signing off on completed scheduled work as per site procedures.
- Assists residents in keeping their rooms neat and tidy.
- Checks and restocks housekeeping supplies. Reports to Support Services Manager when supplies are low.
- Assists with food preparation including washing, preparation and delivery of food and ware supplies.
- Assists in the receiving, distribution, storage and maintaining of stock and supplies.
- Assists residents as required, treating residents with dignity and demonstrates an attitude of caring.
- Performs the day-to-day food services activities related to the preparation and provision of meals to residents (this includes less complex food preparation as requested meal/nourishment service set-up and delivery).

- Performs the day-to-day food services activities related to the ware-washing of supplies, and cleaning of the kitchen, all dining areas and the food server.
- Keeps work areas clean, neat and tidy.
- Supports the equipment control system reporting all maintenance issues of food preparation and distribution equipment to the Cook.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.

Essential Skills and Qualifications Include:

- Grade 12 education.
- facility cleaning experience an asset.
- Ability to communicate effectively in English, both verbally and in writing.
- Ability to organize work.
- Ability to operate related equipment.
- Ability to work in teams collaboratively and communicate with others in a respectful manner.
- Physical ability to carry out the duties of the position.
- Ability to follow written and oral instructions, learn procedures and follow routine processes.
